

APPLICATION FOR AN INTER-JURISDICTIONAL PRACTICE PERMIT

- A. This application must be completed by visiting lawyers from British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Ontario, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island and Newfoundland and Labrador in the following circumstances:
 - 1. lawyers seeking permission to provide legal services in Manitoba or respecting the law of Manitoba <u>beyond the 100 business day limit</u> set out in Rule 3-63(1);
 - 2. lawyers <u>who do not qualify</u> to provide legal services on a temporary basis without a permit as set out in Rule 3-63(3); and
 - 3. lawyers seeking permission to practise in Manitoba pending consideration of their application to transfer under Rule 3-68.
- B. This application must be completed by <u>all</u> visiting lawyers from Quebec, the Northwest Territories, Nunavut and the Yukon intending to provide legal services in Manitoba or respecting the law of Manitoba on a temporary basis. (01-07-03) (AM. 14-11-03; 26-09-06; 21-02-07)
